• 2024 USA Cycling Regional MTB XC Championship Series for California and Nevada racers,

• NEW enduro stage in the Parliament Enduro, and Race 3 as the NCNCA XC District Championship.

The series is an event fundraiser for YBONC programs supporting Nevada County youth bike clubs for middle school and high school ages. YBONC was founded in 2008 and today's membership data shows over 340 youth participate annually in organized youth bike club rides, trail and bike park stewardship projects, and lots of outdoors biking activities. Trail planning started 2019, environmental approved 2021, and build started in 2022. Please thank them in person during the Dirt Daze Event (May 6th) or if you see them on the trails or other races!
- With over 30 years of experience around Mountain Bike racing, Laurent Frieden has joined the CA Dirt MTB Series team to help organize a new and exciting event at the beautiful shoreline of NID's Scotts Flat Lake Campground, only 15 driving minutes from downtown Nevada City, CA. <u>Race 4 Enduro proceeds for BONC</u>, and XC/ST proceeds for YBONC!
- The Cross-Country (XC) course is a mix of fun and fast rolling single track, spiced with a few challenging climbs and a diverse variety of landscape and trail undergrounds, including a few bridges and water crossings, and a Start/Finish area at the boat ramp, a perfect spectator location for photos and cheering. The Short Track (ST) race is in the same location for spectators to view racers on the entire ST course.
- California Dirt MTB Series is the next level for NICA athletes beyond league racing, introducing some of the best northern California single track courses with flow bike designed trails, challenging features, and terrain, ideal for collegiate and competitive racers.
- Note: We will announce the last week of April if we need to cancel Race 1 due to snow, extreme weather conditions, etc.
- Race registration is on-line only, closes at 6am Thursday of race week. No on-site race day registration.
- CA Dirt MTB Series, USAC Regional MTB Championship Series, NCNCA District Championship (Race 3 only) are a USA Cycling sanctioned event series.



PREP WORK BEFORE ON-LINE REGISTRATION & SERIES RULEBOOK / REQUIREMENTS

Read - Important Steps Below to Save You Grief and Time Before You Register Online at BikeReg

- Race registration is on-line BikeReg only. No on-site race day registration.
 Series race registration buttons, Click Here
- On-line registration closes at 6am Thursday of each race week! No Race Day Walk-up Registration.
 - We need a couple of days to confirm racer registration data before downloading racer registration data for: timing services, contact racers (who missed clicking on the "I Agree" box for the digital waiver)
- Series Rulebook, prep work for on-line registration, registration buttons, refund policy, start times, course map,
 & more, url to official event website ... Click Here
 - Document contains links to series rulebook, about USA Cycling membership/license info, and required steps before registering online for a race, categories/age groups, race schedule, ready on race day, point system/awards info, lodging and campground links, etc.
- Renew your USAC license or purchase an annual license or 1 Day License if you are not a USAC license holder.
- Log into your USAC license profile or open the USAC mobile app to display and/or update your XC category status for this race season, Example: For XC-Cross Country Race entry Cat 1 M 40-49 your category should match the below.



- Attention racers, BEFORE registering for any of series races on-line at BikeReg, update your USAC racer profile XC category (upgrade or downgrade). Why? Your race category/age group as stated on your current year USA Cycling race license is the category/age to register for a race in this series when doing on-line BikeReg registration. BikeReg emails us immediately if there is a difference between your USA Cycling MTB profile race license for XC category vs. what you're registered to race and that forces you to perform an override during the on-line registration process.
- PLEASE upgrade your XC category or state residency BEFORE you register for a race on-line ... <u>Click Here</u> There is no on-site race day registration or internet services at our venues.

Again, register for a race category/age as stated on your race license so your racer data is correct before we download BikeReg racer data for timing services and race plate assignments.

- If everything matches on race day check-in volunteers will hand you your assigned race plate no. so you can warm
 up before your start time. If your registration category/age does not match you'll be holding up the check-in line or
 pulled to the side to speak with the event director or USA Cycling official on site.
 You can avoid race day hold ups at the check-in line on RACE Day if you update your USAC profile XC category
 and state residence BEFORE you register on-line.
- For Pro/Cat 1-Expert/Cat 2-Sport Racers (Experienced Racers w/Expired USAC License):
 - 2-3 weeks BEFORE, please log-in to USAC to purchase/renew/upgrade/downgrade category in your race profile doing on-line BikeReg registration.
 - If you have an EXPIRED USAC annual license, a \$35 One-Day (Experienced) License is required (allowed one
 time a year), and may be purchased <u>on-line only</u> at <u>USAC</u> membership, click on "Join/Renew" Button and login
 to your racer account. Experienced Racer 1 day licenses are NOT AVAILABLE at race venue on Race Day <u>or</u>
 during BikeReg race registration.
 - Only a 1 Day Race License for Cat 3-Beginners may be purchased on-line at BikeReg.
 - 1 Day Race License racers awarded race day medals.
 - 1 Day Race Licensed racers points are not applied to overall series points.
 - Explanation of USA Cycling race fees for "Experienced ONE Day License", Click Here.

- For Cat 3 Racers (Beginner Racers):
 - Available at on-line BikeReg registration, \$15, when registering to race for a race.
 - For series points, a 2024 USAC License is required. Do this BEFORE you register on-line at BikeReg for Race 1, and a 2024 USAC license is required for Race 1/2/3/4. Any One Day License fee is applied toward online purchasing an annual license at <u>USACycling</u> if you recently raced another USAC sanctioned race outside of the CA Dirt MTB Series.
- For NEW racers to USAC sanctioned races (but not a beginner racer), has raced other races and just wants to race (not interested in earning series points):
 - (TRISH...Enter your info here) If a racer is interested in this series points, any One Day License fee is applied toward online purchasing an annual license at <u>USACycling</u>.
- After any changes at USA Cycling, wait 24 hours before registering on-line for a race so USAC racer data downloads to BikeReg site, then register on-line at BikeReg the following day.
- <u>Problems with your USAC license</u>, PLEASE update your racer profile <u>BEFORE registering for races in this series</u>. Upgrades or downgrades can be performed with:
 - USA Cycling's mobile app
- <u>Series REFUND Policy</u>: CA Dirt MTB Series is an event fundraiser, no monetary refunds issued. Refund
 requests is a coupon code toward another 2024 or 2025 race registration, or donation for YBONC
 Programs. Contact us by email (no IM or calls) and we will reply with a registration coupon code to apply for a

- Why should I get an annual USA Cycling Race License/Membership? Here's benefits and why....Click Here
- The age on 12/31/24 is your race age per USAC rulebook.
- You do not need a race license If you are racing in the age 5 y.o. or under category in this series. A parent or legal
 guardian may mentor/escort your child during the race after an adult has signed an event volunteer waiver for racer. A
 junior racer age 5-7 y.o. must have a completed event waiver and complete one lap by 1HH:30MM.
 Yes, we've had determined young shredders complete a 3-4 mile course in the past, or the under 1 mile ST course.
- Waivers are to be completed online.
 - PLEASE ... CLICK the "I Agree" button for digital waiver when registering for a race at BikeReg. We have gone paperless; racer waivers are digital for us to download and print for race day check-in. This makes race day check-in line move fast! We will call you to log into BikeReg and click the "I AGREE" button if your racer name shows on BikeReg's pending racer waiver report.

- o A current annual USAC race license holder,
- o California or Nevada state residence appears on USAC race license,
- Race 1/2/3/4 (Race 4 points applies to 2025 USAC Regionals), exception where discipline is not offered at a race venue.
- Overall series point ties determined by Race 4 fastest finish time for category/age.
- Receive USAC Regional medal for top 1-2-3 total overall series points.

California Dirt MTB Series:

- Completed on-line event waivers at BikeReg registration.
- A current USAC race license holder,
- o Race 1/2/3/4 for ST/XC, Races 3/4 for eBike, Race 4 for Enduro.
- Short Track (ST) and Cross Country (XC) 1/2/3 place winners by category/age receive CA Dirt MTB race day medals.
- Overall series point ties determined by Race 4 fastest finish time for category/age.
- Racer receives championship jersey with winner insignia stripe on sleeve at Race 4, complete
 jersey info (name, cat/age, jersey size/gender, and shipping address at BikeReg <u>Click Here</u>

NEW ... NCNCA XC District Championship (Race 3):

- Completed on-line event waivers at BikeReg registration.
- A current USAC race license holder.
- Resident in a NCNCA district area counties.
- Race 1/2/3/4 for XC.
- o XC 1/2/3 place winners by category/age receive NCNCA award on race day
- Racer receives NCNCA XC District Championship medal, 1/2/3 place winners by category/age receive race day medals.

USAC 1 Day Race Licenses or ReNew For an Annual Race License:

- > \$35 Experienced Racers 1 Day Race License, or Renew your Annual USAC License/Membership
 - For Pro/Cat 1-Expert/Cat 2-Sport Racers
 - Available to purchase on-line at USAC only, a 1 time/yr for expired USAC license holders.
 - Log-in to your USAC account.
 - Not available to purchase on-line at BikeReg)
- > \$15 Cat 3-Beginner (available to purchase on-line at BikeReg)
 - Is applied toward a purchase 2024 USAC annual license on-line at USA Cycling if your raced at another USAC sanctioned race. If you do this, PLEASE purchase an annual USA Cycling license 2 weeks before Race 1 AND before you register on-line at BikeReg.
- ➤ 1 Day Race USAC licensed racers may receive race day award medals.
- > 1 Day Race USAC licensed racer's points do NOT accrue to overall series points.

Racing 1/2/3/4 are required for both series overall points.
- USA Cycling racer profile points start a new accrual round after completion of 2024 USA Cycling's MTB National Championships, July 17-21, 2024, and 2024 Gravity MTB National Championships, July 31-August 4, 2024. See below about nationals.
- <u>Any USA Cycling license questions</u>, please contact USA Cycling Membership Services department at membership@usacycling.org or 719-434-4200. We do not have access to USA Cycling's system.
- Racers who finish in the **top-15** of their entry category and age group at the end of Race 3 qualify for 2024 USA Cycling's MTB National Championships, see below links for qualifications.

• CA Dirt MTB Series Race 4 points applies to USA Cycling 2025 points system for 2025 Nationals.

Be Ready for Race Day at Venues

REQUIRED ...Make a screen capture for your current USAC license with your XC:##
 This must match the category you are registered to race on race day when you check-in.
 Your 2024 USAC race license shows your cat/age group, and race age to our check-in volunteers

Why? Cell phone service is poor at our race venues and there's a good chance you will not be able to do an online USAC race license edit with your cell phone to perform a category upgrade or downgrade...copy or screen capture works.

• Check-in volunteers confirm to match your race entry with your USAC race license for XC category and age: Pro (or UCI) Cat 1 Cat 2 Cat 3.

No on-site RACE Day Walk-Up Registration

- Why? All race event waivers are digital, license status verified, processed online at BikeReg registration. We print digitally signed racer waivers for check-in volunteers and attach race results with post event paperwork.
- Keep our event safe. Please stay home if you have any cold-like symptoms.
- Attach your race plate to your bars with cables on the backside and it is facing forward for course marshals to read and report your race plate number by radio for any reason as you are racing by them. (If you can read your race plate number when sitting on the saddle, re-attach your race plate on the bars again so it's facing forward like car headlights.)



- Know your start time and arrive 10 minutes early for pre-race announcements.
- Racers must start/finish on the same bike, no exchange of parts or aid from others unless you carry it
 yourself, per USAC rules.
- If you're racing more than one race, you will receive a race plate for each race entry.
- No littering PLEASE. Place any sport food wrappers in your pockets or underneath shorts leg. Bring a trash bag for your personal trash or recyclable items and please take your trash home. Pack-It-In Pack-It-Out Policy!
- Check Lost & Found Box at the next race if you lost any item(s) at previous race.
- If you are spectating, camping, PLEASE leave no trace, pack it in/pack it out to help us keep our landowners happy.
- Our events follow state and local CoVID guidelines based on each race location by county. With
 new viruses each year, and people not fully vaccinated, please social distance or mask up in public and
 at check-in until USAC blows his start whistle to prevent spreading of illness to our staff of volunteers
